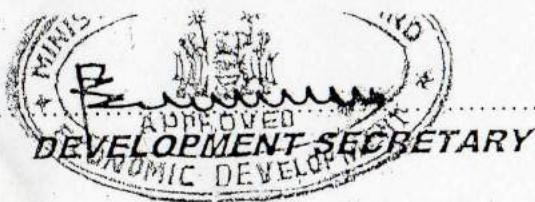

RECOMMENDATION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF LAMIN AND KADIA BAH ACADEMY, PATE BANA MARANK MAKENI.

With reference to the above subject, I am directed to write and inform you that a thorough assessment has been done by the Monitoring and Evaluation Officer, of the Development Planning Unit of the Makeni City Council and his findings are that the School has been in existence since 2019/2020 academic year.

The School is located in a highly populated area and it has an enrolment of Two Hundred and Sixty (260) Pupils of which One Hundred and Fifty (150) are Boys and One Hundred and Ten (110) are Girls.

Children of the Secondary School have proven records of excellent performance in the BECE Exams and therefore graduate of the Junior School will continue on to the level of the Mission.
